fantastic Bowls Club has to offer.







WHAT WOULD YOU DO? - WEEK 17

Last week's WWYD?
Week 16 pictured right.
Suggested shot indicated
in Red. This would have to
be played with perfect

weight to be successful. Also with the opponent having a bowl to come, he could play with weight, as he has all the back bowls! (That's the problem, when most of your bowls are wide or short.)

Regular correspondent Jeff Dardel suggests:

- 1. Forehand to push jack to be just behind the shot bowl.
- 2. Forehand, slightly over draw weight, to hit

left hand side of the opposition's best bowl so that that bowl will finish between our two bowls.

- 3. Backhand to push jack to be close to our "2 o'clock" 3rd bowl. Quite risky.
- 4. Forehand to push our 2nd bowl to rest behind the jack. Also, quite risky. Prefer Option 1.

A new set of Scenarios:


- 1. Consider 4 types of shots:

- 3. Which shot would you be most confident of making?


Scenario A3: — You have the bowls




