



WHAT WOULD YOU DO? - WEEK 9

Last week's WWYD? Week 8 pictured right, firstly it is your 2nds bowl, so still plenty more to come. I would like the backhand, to come under the pink bowl at 8 o'clock to trail the jack or sit on the shot bowl, or possibly hit that bowl up (and out of the way).




Regular correspondent, Jeff Dardel suggests a similar approach, "Backhand to push out the opposition shot/ or hit the jack back 1/2 feet opening up the head assisting our 3rd & Skip. (If a bit wide, this could push our 2nd shot closer to the jack.)"
