



ACTIVITY 9-SIT & STAY

Place the mat on T & the jack at 28m

Equipment needed 1 mat, 1 jack & 5 bowls

Make it easier by removing the short bowls from the head & more difficult by adding more short bowls into the head.



with enough weight to stay for shot. Play four bowls on forehand then four bowls on backhand.

Remove the red bowl








WHAT WOULD YOU DO? - WEEK 20




