It seems a long way ahead, but MPBR are requesting clubs nominate their divisions by early JULY! So, numbers of players is important.



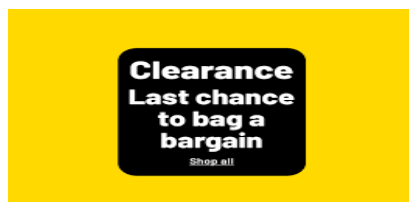
